The day after we returned from the library dedication, The teacher in Ndaka Ndaka in Ndaka teacher training workshop (Step One) (Workshop) teacher center visited. This workshop engaged teachers to begin teaching their students to read and write in the local language.

On the last day of the training, the teachers practiced their new skills by teaching a lesson to some of the local students. During the practice session, one of the teachers exclaimed, "It worked! They are beginning to read!"



Working from this pilot program, we should be starting more slowly in the second language in the project. We believe that a qualified teacher can be found to supervise the first language program with our other resources.

In both languages there are well materials to be produced for the school year as well as the low grade materials and materials for the next year. Pay for students for the work made with the teachers and program coordination to make the important project ahead.
