A Long Awaited Dream

For more than 20 years, Tim has been advocating for mother-tongue-based multilingual education for Solomon Islands schools. Working with the Solomon Islands Ministry of Education more than 10 years ago, he helped launch a very successful pilot program in 2 language communities. For a variety of reasons, support for that program was dropped and nothing has been done to revive it.

However, this year, the government has included a restart in the budget! We are grateful for this development. Pray it can be implemented well.

In addition, we have agreed to assist the Bauro translation team on a plan for literacy. Another opportunity is the possible development of a preschool curriculum and literacy program for Roviana speakers.
